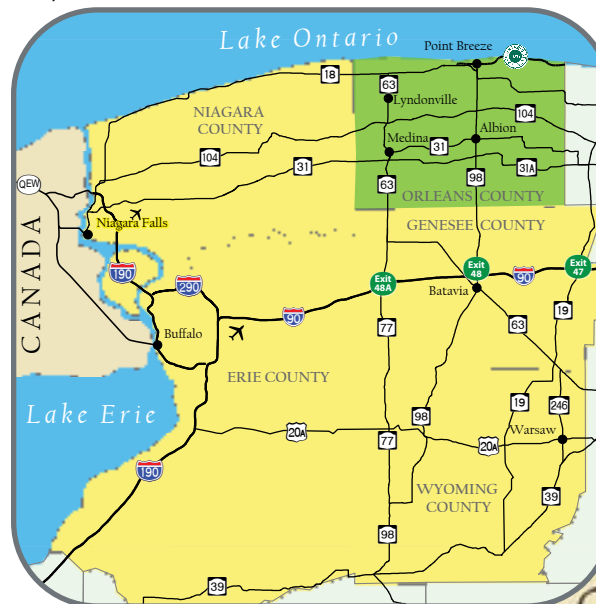

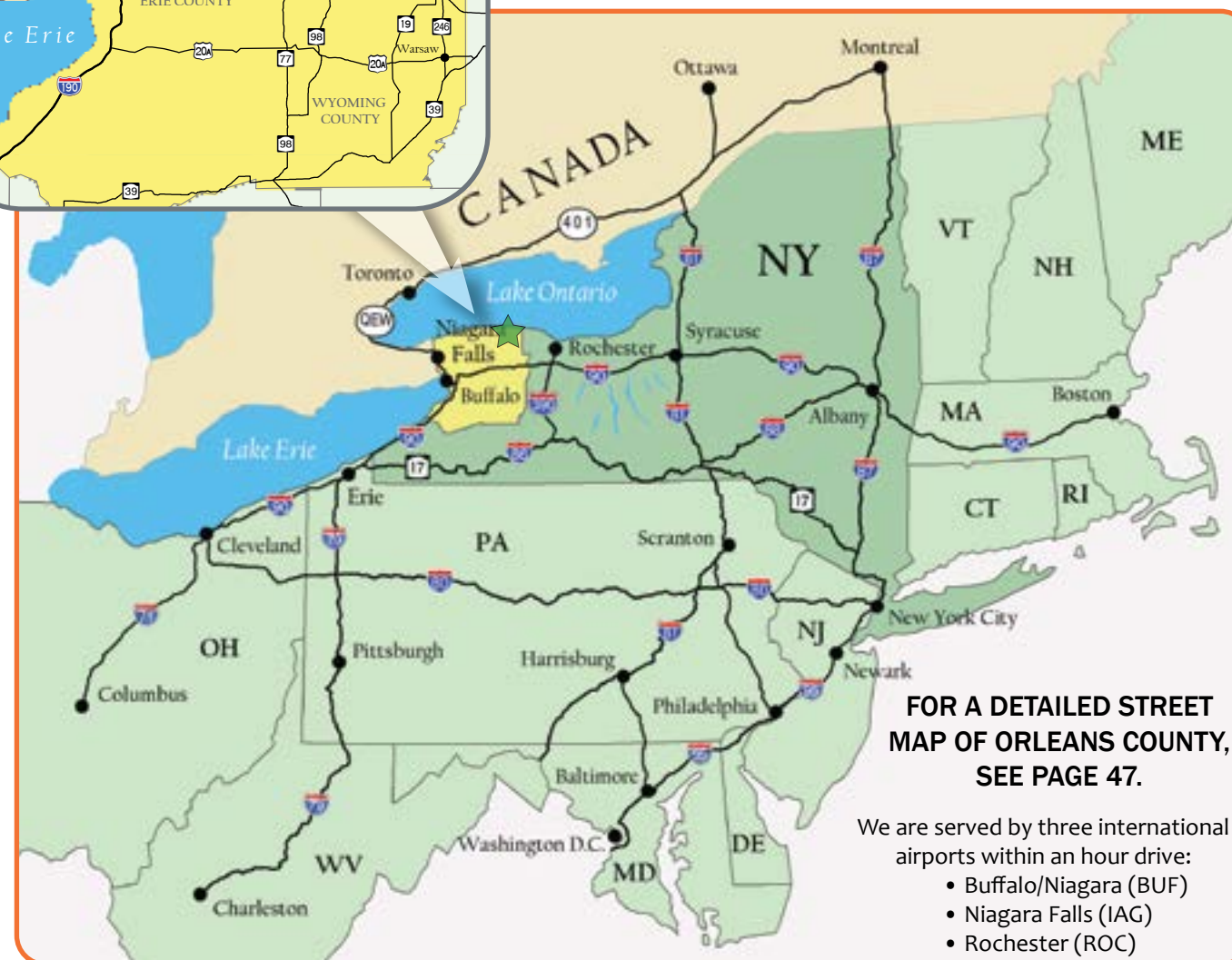
LOCATION: Conveniently located halfway between the Buffalo/ Niagara Falls & the Rochester/Finger Lakes regions, Orleans County is accessible from the New York State Thruway (I-90) by Exits 48 at Batavia and 48A at Pembroke/Corfu. For a more scenic and adventurous drive, follow one of America’s Scenic Byways—the Seaway Trail on the Lake Ontario State Parkway, which parallels the shoreline at the northern border of the county or cruise the historic Erie Canal along the 25 mile stone dust towpath trail or waterway.



CLIMATE: The area’s climate is tempered by Lake Ontario, which remains unfrozen year round. As a result, Orleans County enjoys the benefit of all four seasons, with average summer temperatures in the upper 70’s°F and winter in the low 30’s°F, making it an ideal location for growing a wide variety of crops on approximately 500 farms and nearly 133,000 acres.

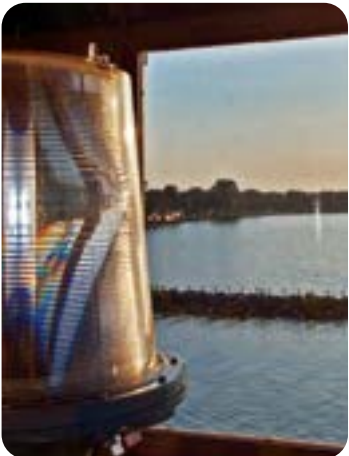

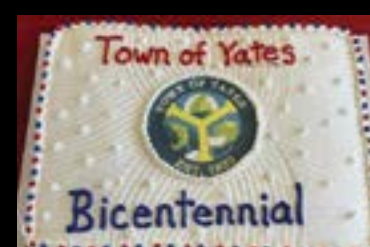

Welcome to Orleans County!

Whether you are merely traveling through, or are staying for a while, we at the Orleans County Department of History encourage you to note the continuum of change that has formed this county.

Located on the south shore of the mighty Lake Ontario, our seemingly serene landscape belies the geological sagas that formed it. "The Lake", this immense freshwater resource, determines our climate and agriculture. The fertile soil formed by receding glaciers, the proximity to the lake and the industriousness of our farmers result in an ever-changing agricultural landscape throughout the year: acres of blossoming fruit trees in spring, fields of corn in summer, roadside stands laden with colorful produce in the fall.

As you traverse the county, note the barns which enhance our rural skyline. Barns make us aware of our dependence of the land and connect the past to the present in a very elemental way.

You will also note the wide variety of architectural styles of our homes, the resourcefulness and industry of the early builders who used cobblestone and sandstone, the ingenuity and daring of those who envisioned the Erie Canal.

Residents of Orleans appreciate their architectural heritage as evidenced by the stalwart renovations of heritage buildings: Albion's Pratt Theater, the Holley High School, the Weber Hotel in Lyndonville, and in Medina - Bent's Opera House, Hart House Hotel, and The Walsh Hotel.

Eye-catching blue and yellow historic markers located throughout the county provide information about notable people and events. A visit the Cobblestone Museum in Gaines will enhance your experience.

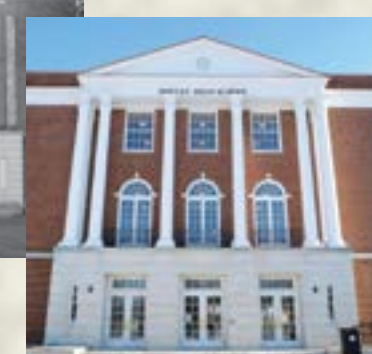



In December 1916, the original Oak Orchard Lighthouse was swept away in a storm. NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES

BENT'S OPERA HOUSE

444 Main St., Medina 585-318-2110

Opened in 1865 as the center of the arts. The upper floors had been vacant since the mid-1900s. In 2012, NYS Preservation League deemed Bent's as one of "Seven to Save". BOH was restored to its original splendor, opening in 2021 including Harvest Restaurant, a 10 room boutique hotel and event center.

COBBLESTONE HISTORIC DISTRICT

14393 Ridge Rd W, Albion
cobblestonemuseum.org
The Cobblestone Museum in Childs, NY is the only cobblestone museum in the world. It showcases the unique masonry construction method using stones rounded and polished into cobble by glacial action.

COURTHOUSE SQUARE HISTORIC DISTRICT

N. Main St. & Park Ave, Albion 585-589-4174
In the heart of Albion, the county seat, stands the 1858 Greek Revival Style dome County Courthouse and the 1882 County Clerk's Building, surrounded by 34 architecturally significant structures. Seven churches face the square, one of which was built in 1894 by George M. Pullman. Group tours by appointment.

GAINES BASIN ROAD COBBLESTONE SCHOOLHOUSE

Gaines Basin Rd, Albion (just north of the Erie Canal). New to the National Register of Historic Places is an original one-room cobblestone schoolhouse built in 1832 and last used in 1944. The Orleans County Historical Society recently completed renovations and it's used as a meeting house.

HILLSIDE CEMETERY

Rt 237 & South Holley Rd, Holley
Established in 1866, this beautiful cemetery demonstrates the romantic style of the Rural Cemetery Movement in its eastern section, while the western section shows the more recent Lawn Style. The highlight is a stunning Gothic Revival chapel built of Medina Sandstone in 1894. Pick up self-guided walking tour at the garage.

MEDINA ARMORY & CO. F MEM'L

306 Pearl St., Medina

Decommissioned in 1977, the Medina Armory is the current home of the YMCA. The Company F monument was erected in 2008 and features the names of local soldiers who trained at the armory from 1898 to 1947. A 1400 lbs. bronze statues was installed in 2019 in honor of all military veterans.

MOUNT ALBION CEMETERY

Rte 31E, Albion 585-589-4174
Sitting on over 75 acres of land, this 1840's rural cemetery's charm is enhanced by handsome trees, terraced hillsides and rolling terrain. Its notable highlights include the Soldiers and Sailors Monument — a local Civil War memorial that you can climb to the top of, a chapel and entrance arch.

PRATT ARTS CENTER

The 1882 Pratt Theater is on the 3rd floor of the building and is used for events. The 1882 Grand Army of the Republic Room on the 3rd floor of 114 North Main St. contains original murals from post-Civil War and is available as a conference center. By appointment

PULLMAN UNIVERSALIST CHURCH

East Park St., Albion (corner of N. Main St.)
George Pullman (1831-1897), noted industrialist, was once a resident of Albion and later became the manufacturer of Pullman Railroad Cars. One of his local legacies is the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church in Albion, which he built in 1894 to honor his parents' memory. Includes several famed Tiffany Stained glass windows.

Note: The Villages of Albion, Holley, Lyndonville and Medina are also listed on the National Register of Historic Places.



WATERWAYS

Whether paddling down the meandering gorge of the Oak Orchard River or navigating the calm waters of the grand Erie Canal, you'll get your fill of "blue space therapy" around every bend. Our canal port villages of Albion, Holley and Medina offer docking right along side the downtown historic districts and within an easy walk to restaurants, shops and museums. If sailing, cruising, water-skiing, paddle boarding or sport fishing is your passion, the Lake Ontario shoreline and our sheltered Oak Orchard Harbor should not be missed.

VILLAGE OF HOLLEY

The Holley Canal Port, operated by the Village of Holley, is a favorite stop for boaters traveling on the Erie Canal. Boaters are greeted by a boardwalk, playground, gazebo and nature trails to the waterfall & village square. Docking facilities include water, electric service and comfort station with showers, public restroom. Plan your visit around the Friday night summer concert series at the Gazebo from June - August.

VILLAGE OF ALBION

The flash of silver welcoming visitors by boat or by land is the dome of the 1858 County Courthouse. Canalside Park offers boat docking facilities and a landscaped park for watching the lift bridge operations. Amenities include water, electric service and comfort station with showers. Shops & restaurants are all within walking distance. The Strawberry Festival in June is one of the highlights of this community. Plan your visit on Thursday evenings late June-August for their summer concert series on the Canal.

VILLAGE OF MEDINA

The restored 19th century downtown is replete with specialty shops, restaurants and Erie Canal Marine Park on the wide turning area of the canal. Take a leisurely hike along the towpath east to the Medina Falls & Aqueduct where the Oak Orchard River passes below the canal. Amenities include pump out station, water, electric service and comfort station with showers. Cruise Nights, featuring classic/vintage

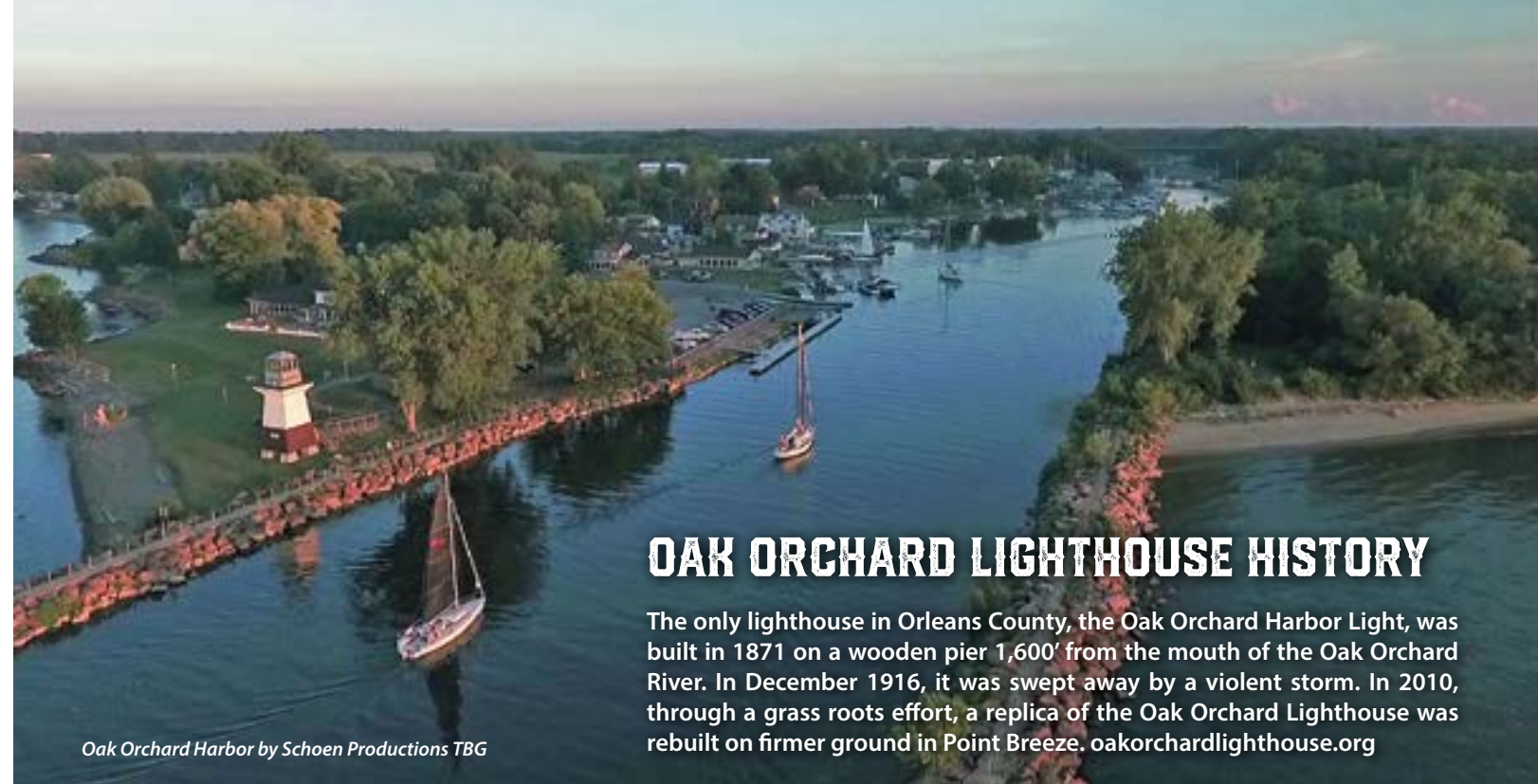
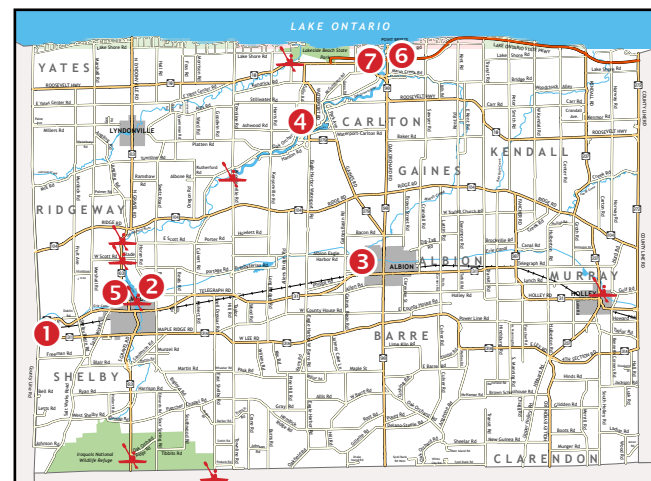

OAK ORCHARD LIGHTHOUSE HISTORY

The only lighthouse in Orleans County, the Oak Orchard Harbor Light, was built in 1871 on a wooden pier 1,600' from the mouth of the Oak Orchard River. In December 1916, it was swept away by a violent storm. In 2010, through a grass roots effort, a replica of the Oak Orchard Lighthouse was rebuilt on firmer ground in Point Breeze. oakorchardlighthouse.org

- You'll want to take the drive up to catch some spectacular summer sunsets!



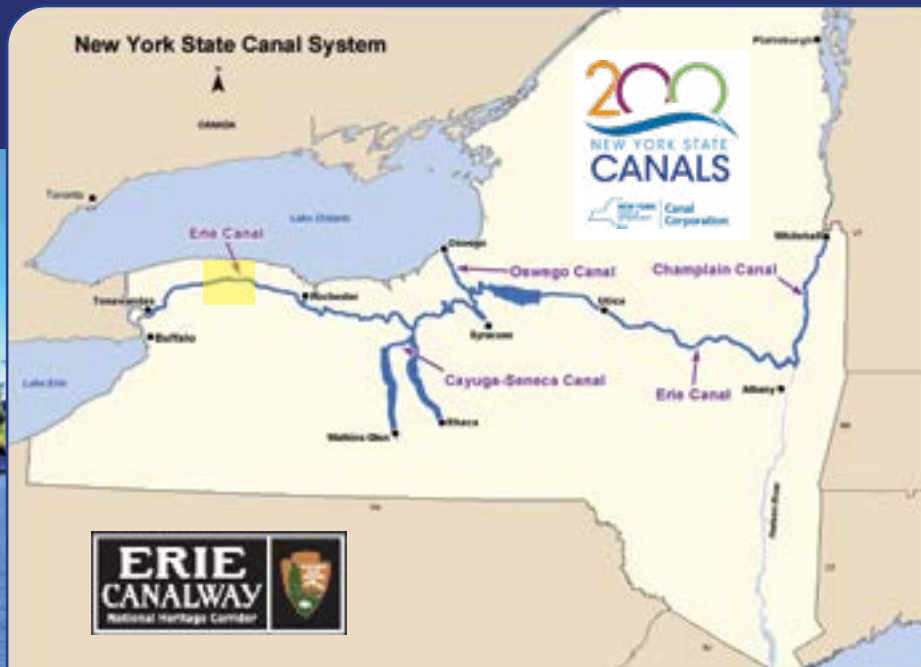

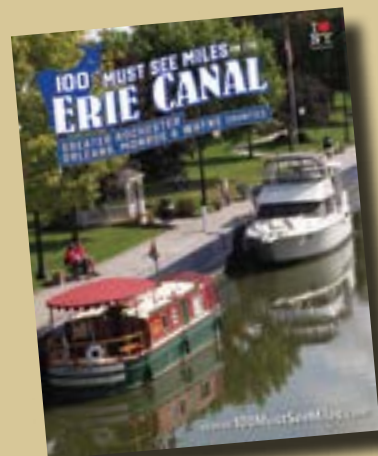

MORE HAPPY TRAILS!

COBBLESTONE TRAIL ON RIDGE ROAD: The “Ridge” sits upon a ridge of sand once forming the shoreline of ancient Lake Iroquois before receding 10,000 years ago. It was first used by the Senecas and Iroquois, and in 1798 a road was traced through the forest near the ridge, transforming the trail into a stage coach turnpike. The Village Inn at Childs is the only surviving stage coach stop. The Ridge is often referred to as “the road of the cobblestone houses,” for there are more such buildings along its 25 miles from Rochester than on any highway in America. The Cobblestone Museum in Childs is the only cobblestone museum in the world. It showcases the unique masonry construction method using stones rounded and polished into cobble by glacial action. Over 10,800 acres of wooded swamp, marshland and meadows provide a stopping point for an estimated 100,000 Canada geese and 266 species of birds during their spring and fall migrations. Sixty species are considered year-round residents. Activities include nature trails, overlooks, photography blind (by permit), canoeing in designated areas, fishing, hunting (by permit) and cross country skiing/snowshoeing. The visitor center is open weekdays 7:30AM-4PM year-round and weekends 9AM-5PM spring and fall. Trails and overlooks are open sunrise to sunset, year-round. Fishing areas are open from sunrise to sunset within state seasons. THE MEDINA RAILROAD MUSEUM



Located in the old New York Central freight depot in Medina, NY, the Medina Railroad Museum is one of the largest freight depot museums in New York State. The

building itself was built in 1905-06, and is one of the largest (301ft. by 34ft.), last surviving wooden freight depots in the United States.

Founded in 1997, the museum houses over 7,000 artifacts covering the history of railroads. Exhibits feature vintage toy trains from the legendary manufacturers like Lionel, Marx and American Flyer. There is also an extensive firefighting exhibit on display with over 460 old fire helmets.

Children and adults alike are awed by the immense 204ft. long by 14ft. wide HO scale layout, one of the largest in the nation. The interactive exhibit features twelve sets of one-hundred-car trains, featuring engines from various railroad lines as New York Central,

Erie, Lackawanna, Pennsylvania, Lehigh Valley, Nickel Plate, Santa Fe, Erie Lackawanna, and others. The Museum's vintage trains offer excursions to Lockport and back several times per year for special events. Train season is March through October, with magical Polar Express rides after Thanksgiving through mid-December.
