


Year Round Fishing at the Oak!















The open waters of Lake Ontario and the tributaries of Orleans County offer outstanding year round trout and salmon fishing - it's a top tier fishing destination! Along with prolific warm water inland action, Orleans County is a mecca for young and old, novice and experienced.

A great fishery means little if you do not have the support facilities. Orleans County shines with full service marinas, well stocked tackle shops, unique restaurants and shopping. Multiple lodging options offer a comfortable place to lay your head at night after an exciting day of fishing.

In the lush farmlands of Western New York between Niagara Falls to the west and Rochester to the east, Orleans County offers a step back from the routine hustle and bustle. For the family or for a break from fishing, there are farm markets and wineries to visit, quaint canaltown villages of Albion, Medina & Holley to explore, cobblestone and train museums, a lighthouse keeper's ladder to climb and the only place in New York State that you can drive *under* the Erie Canal.

THE "OAK"

...an Alluring and Tranquil Port on Lake Ontario

Point Breeze Harbor lies at the coastal hamlet of Point Breeze at the mouth of the Oak Orchard River. Long ago, Point Breeze and the area along the Oak Orchard was a Native American settlement, known as the "Black North" for the dense forest which made passage in daylight as dark as night.

The lower five-mile reach of the Oak has carved 50-foot deep meanders in the Queenston shale, with purple and green walls still topped by an Oak forest. Much of the river is undisturbed as a state-protected fish and wildlife habitat area.

Today, the harbor is a gateway to the Great Lakes Seaway Trail, designated one of America's Byways, hugging the Lake Ontario coastline. The area boasts public parks and a full service port. You can watch the sun melt into Lake Ontario, listen to the sullen roar of breaking waves, fish for colossal trout and salmon, browse a marina chandlery, or dine leisurely on the waterfront.

There is a diverse fishery on Lake Ontario, and this is especially true of the Orleans County, NY open lake and tributary waters. Shore casters, wading anglers, small boat in-shore trollers or boaters rigged to handle the big off-shore waters – Orleans County has something for you.

For warm water anglers, the lake and tribs provide fine Smallmouth Bass fishing and the Perch fishing in Spring and Fall can be excellent. But where the Orleans County waters really shine is for the fantastic year round cold water trout and salmon species like King (Chinook) salmon, Coho (Silver) salmon, Atlantic salmon, Steelhead (Rainbow trout), Brown trout and Lake trout.

In the Spring as the trib waters and open lake warms, the trout and salmon move in-shore. These fish are hungry and the fishing action is often as simple as finding the warmest water where the trout and salmon are feeding on baitfish.

Spring fishing allows for shoreline and pier anglers to catch trout and salmon. It also makes fishing from a small boat using simple flat line or in-line planer board techniques a viable option instead of big water downrigger methods. In close proximity to the shoreline, anglers can choose good weather days that provide for a safe and fun outing.

As the open lake warms through spring and summer, the trout and salmon move off-shore into their preferred temperature zones. Brown trout generally don't move far off-shore but stick close to where their preferred temperature intercepts bottom structure. Other trout and salmon like Kings, Lake trout and Steelhead roam the open lake in cool deep water shadowing baitfish.

As Fall approaches, trout and salmon move back in-shore. Big, mature King salmon lead the way! Brown trout and Steelhead are not far behind with the small boat angler and shore bound caster back in action! Trout and salmon move upstream into the tribs later in the Fall. Some of the best and concentrated fishing action Orleans County is known for takes place for wading anglers. Steelhead complete the seasonal fishing scene with action in the tribs all winter and then spring when they move back into the open Lake.

CHARTER & GUIDE SERVICES

If you are new to salmon and trout fishing, consider the services of a professional charter captain or licensed guide. View our list on pages 18-19. The cost of the charter trip or trib licensed guide is a small price to pay for local knowledge and skill that these professionals have developed over many years of fishing. Charter captains rely on sonar and probes for speed and temperature at trolling depth. Downriggers are an important tool but there are times when dipseys, leadcore, copper line, drop weights and/or planer boards work well. Trib guides rely on water flow data and run timing that match up for ideal conditions. You could go home with some great fillets or catch and release memories and a mind full of ideas and techniques for your next DIY trip!

RESOURCES

There are many tools available that can greatly increase fishing success. Consult with websites, social media, apps and forums that provide local fishing reports. Online surface temperatures, wind and current maps can place you in the trout and salmon preferred

INLAND & TRIBUTARY FISHING

"OAK" & TRIBS · ERIE CANAL · LAKE ALICE · GLENWOOD LAKE

he fish rich waters of Orleans County are alive with the sound of "FISH ON" all year long! No matter if you are an avid fly fisherman or a novice angler, the inland waters and tribs have plenty to offer everyone. Are you looking for a laid back place to spend a lazy summer's afternoon? Do you seek a flowing trib to ply your skills at presenting a perfect fly to a migrating trout or salmon? No matter what you are looking for, Orleans County has the water for you.

Do you want to take the kids for a fun fishing outing for active panfish? How about a place where huge Carp, Northern Pike and Smallmouth Bass can be hooked with the right presentation? The inland waters and tribs of Orleans County can provide you with all this and more.

In the Spring, Summer and Fall, warm water species are readily available in the inland waters, tribs and smaller lakes. Lake Alice (Waterport Pond), Glenwood Lake and miles and miles of the Erie Canal provide top notch fishing action. Spring and Fall bring good catches of Bullhead, Walleye, Perch and Northern Pike. Summer and Fall are geared more for Smallmouth and Largemouth Bass. Of course the much overlooked Carp are available in most all waters.

Fall, Winter and Spring brings the migratory runs of King, Coho and Atlantic salmon as well as Brown trout and Steelhead. These trophy fish enter the tribs from Lake Ontario to make their spawning runs and offer a truly World Class fishery that has been well documented in fishing magazines. People come from all over the country and world for this great fishery as it can only be experienced here in Orleans County. In the Fall there can be other anglers, yet all experience fantastic fishing with plenty of fish to go around. A little legwork will often get you to less crowded spots.

OAK ORCHARD RIVER ACCESS AREA

In order to provide better access on the upper section of the Oak Orchard River, the Orleans County Legislature leases

approximately 15.8 acres of land from a private landowner. This lease provides free public access for fishing and outdoor recreation activities on nearly a mile of land from the Park Avenue Extension trail south to the Brookfield Power Company lands at Waterport Dam. Look for the green signs and please respect private property in the area. Access area rules are available at local tackle shops and online at orleanscountyfishing.com.



With cooperating cold temperatures and ice, Winter brings on Perch, Walleye and Northern Pike fishing. On the Oak, thanks to an upstream hydro-dam, anglers find open water rod and reel chances to entice Steelhead wintering over in deep pools. Just remember to keep an eye on your surroundings during this cold weather time of the year for ice breaking loose and debris coming downstream between you and the shoreline. When ice fishing, always be sure of the thickness of the ice for safety and be aware of any specific site rules like PFD requirements on the Brookfield Power Company land near the hydro-dam.

The trib and inland waters of Orleans County supply unmatched year round fishing opportunities. Come enjoy all that we have to offer once and you'll be HOOKED for a lifetime.

POPULAR FISH SPECIES OF ORLEANS COUNTY

ATLANTIC SALMON

Once a native fish to Lake Ontario, an Atlantic Salmon restoration program is underway for this great fighting



CHINOOK SALMON

Ontario.

Also known as King Salmon, they are some of the most sought-after trophies of Lake Ontario and tributaries. They can



be found from April through September on Lake Ontario and in October and November in the tributaries of Orleans County.

COHO SALMON


Although smaller than the Chinook Salmon, the Coho or Silver Salmon is considered by many to give a more active fight.



Coho follow the Chinook Salmon up the tributaries for their spawning run later in the fall of the year.

BROWN TROUT

Brown Trout in Lake Ontario sometimes exceed 30 pounds. Normally considered an early



LAKE TROUT

Also a native fish in Lake Ontario, Lake Trout are being brought back under a federal stocking program. Lake Trout are usually found near the coolest, deeper water and are long lived fish growing to large sizes.

STEELHEAD/RAINBOW TROUT

The spectacular acrobatics of these fish are known far and wide. Steelhead/Rainbow Trout are available in Lake Ontario Spring, Summer Fall and in the tributaries Fall, Winter and Spring. They are considered an upper level fish in the water column and feed on insects as well as baitfish.

WALLEYE

Walleye are characterized by large canine teeth and can exceed 20 inches. They have a dark spot at the bottom of the first dorsal fin and are yellow/ green in appearance.

YELLOW PERCH

Yellow perch are often found in shallow bays Fall and Spring. They average between 6-10 inches, are a popular ice fishing pursuit and renowned for light taste.

CARP

Popular with shoreline anglers who bait an area then cast and wait, the carp bite gently but battle fierce because of their size. They are large fish and can exceed 20-30 pounds.

SMALLMOUTH BASS

Smallmouth Bass inhabit Lake Ontario and tributaries associated with cobble and submerged aquatic vegetation. Spawning occurs in the tributaries. They average 8 - 15 inches but 20 inch fish are possible.

NORTHERN PIKE

Distinguished by their wedge-shaped heads and large mouths with abundant teeth, Northern Pike have anal and dorsal fins positioned opposite each other near the tail. Pike are most often caught Fall, Winter (ice fishing) and Spring.




